Public Notice Extension of the Public Comment Period Draft Revised Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit Fisk Generating Station in Chicago

The Illinois EPA is planning to issue a revised Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit for the Fisk Generating Station located at 1111 W Cermak Rd in Chicago. The facility is an electric power plant owned by Midwest Generation, LLC. The power plant can generate electricity with eight oil-fired combustion turbine generators that use low-sulfur diesel fuel. These units are operated as “peaking units.”
