### Public Notice Proposed Renewal of the Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit BWAY Corporation in Chicago

BWAY Corporation has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) renew the Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit regulating air emissions from its facility located at 3200 South Kilbourn Avenue in Chicago. The source manufactures lithographed, paint-coated steel containers for the paint and chemical industries. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that the application meets the standards for issuance and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

**The Illinois EPA will hold a public hearing on November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 7:00 pm at the Little Village Lawndale High School Campus Auditorium, 3120 South Kostner Ave. Chicago, IL 60623.** The hearing will be held by the Illinois EPA to receive comments and answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the draft CAAPP permit. The hearing will be held under the Illinois EPA's "Procedures for Permit and Closure Plans," 35 IAC 166, Subpart A. Requests for interpreters (including sign language) must be made by October 22<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted in writing. Email comments originating on third party systems or servers intended for submittal of multiple emails of the same or nearly the same content will not be accepted without prior approval from the hearing officer. The Illinois EPA will accept written public comments on the draft permit during the comment period. **Written comments to Hearing Officer must be received no later than midnight December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 unless otherwise specified.**

The CAAPP is Illinois' operating permit program for major sources of emissions, as required by Title V of the Clean Air Act (Act). The conditions of CAAPP permits are enforceable by the public, as well as by the USEPA and Illinois EPA. In addition to implementing Title V of the Act, CAAPP permits may contain "Title I Conditions," i.e., conditions established under the permit programs for new and modified emission units, pursuant to Title I of the Act. The permit contains no T1 conditions that are being newly established or revised by this application.
